

# BROWNES BOOT CAMP (BBC) - TERMS & CONDITIONS:

All BBC Members and anyone visiting a BBC site either in the U.K. or abroad must comply fully with these Terms and Conditions. They are part of a Member's Contract and essential in protecting our Members' health and safety, the continued use of our training sites and our business.

Should any person entering a BBC site be found not to be complying with our Terms & Conditions they may be denied access, be removed from the site or have their membership suspended or terminated at the discretion of BBC.

BBC Terms and Conditions are available both on request and on our website and we reserve the right to amend/update them at any time. Notification of any amendments/updates will be displayed on the BBC website and BBC social media

## **MEMBERSHIP:**

1 - Application for membership is at the sole discretion of the BBC and its Staff.

2 - Applicants must be 16 years of age or over but anyone under that age is eligible to attend as long as a parental/guardian consent form has been signed and presented to the BBC trainer on site.

3 - Membership entitles the use of our Sites and equipment which may differ from time to time and each membership category has different restrictions which are detailed on our website. Please refer to our website for details of any applicable restrictions.

4 - Should your membership be terminated by BBC you will not be allowed entry to train on any BBC site or use any BBC equipment and your Membership Card MUST be returned to a BBC Trainer. For this purpose, BBC will communicate such Member's personal data, and reason for termination, to other Sites as may be necessary to administer this Rule.

## SITE RULES

1 – BBC Tops are encouraged to be worn at all times during training.

2 - BBC requires all members' to display at all times mutual respect for fellow BBC members and BBC staff. If you do have a specific complaint please direct this to the Managing Director Angus Browne at <a href="mailto:membership@brownesbootcamp.co.uk">membership@brownesbootcamp.co.uk</a>

3 - BBC accepts no responsibility for loss, damaged or stolen property whilst training and are not responsible for the personal belongings of the members or visitors.

4 - All Members must respect the neighbourhood, training site and take all litter home with them.

## **COVID-19 GUIDELINES**

Social distancing and hygiene is VERY important at Brownes Boot Camp under the current circumstances. Please respect other members' space when training. We have our own hand sanitising station but you are welcome to bring your own. Our members and guests have an important role to play to keep everyone safe. If you become ill or have any symptoms or any infections please keep away/isolate for 14 days and DO NOT attend BBC at all. At the current time, you can only participate in the boxing classes with your OWN pads and gloves.

#### DIRECT DEBIT: IMPORTANT MINIMUM CONTRACT TERM IS 6 MONTHS

In order to take advantage of the discounted membership, you must to agree to the following Terms and Conditions. Please note, in agreeing to the below Terms and Conditions, you will be applying for and entering into a legally binding contract with Brownes Boot Camp.

The following specific Terms and Conditions must be complied with at all times and form an integral part of your contractual agreement with BBC.

- 1. Direct Debits can only be created by someone over the age of 18 years.
- 2. You are entering a contract with BBC for a minimum period of 6 months ("Unlimited Boot Camp Sessions DIRECT DEBIT)
- 3. This contract will automatically renew for the same term after the anniversary date. Unless the required notice period of 1 calendar month has been given to cancel the contract.
- 4. Additional charges of up to £20.00 (per month) may be incurred for any unpaid Direct Debit.
- 5. Where members pay by Direct Debit, missed sessions cannot be carried over to the next month.
- 6. Direct Debits cannot be stopped and then re-started to make up sessions.
- 7. Unpaid Direct Debits will be reclaimed within 30 days by Brownes Boot Camp.
- 8. The cancellation of your Direct Debit contract with BBC cannot be made for a minimum period of 5 months. When giving notice of cancellation after the minimum period of 5 months, you must give one month's notice (The minimum term is therefore 6 months in total). We will continue to collect payments until we are notified either in writing or by email that a member wishes to cancel their membership.
- 9. Notice of cancellation must be made in writing and sent by email to <u>membership@brownesbootcamp.co.uk</u>. You will be sent an email confirmation and this should be retained by yourself as proof of receipt of your notice of cancellation, If you do not have access to e-mail you are at liberty to make written notification and hand this to your trainer at your next session. BBC will send you a receipt in writing which should be retained by you as proof of receipt of your notice of cancellation. In the event that you cancel your Direct Debit before the minimum period of 5 months you will be liable for full payment of the remaining period.
- 10. Unused sessions will not be refunded and your contract will not terminate until your membership card has been returned to BBC and confirmed in writing to you.
- 11. Should you wish to freeze your contract you may be eligible to do so under exceptional circumstances and reviewed on a case to case basis. This will be solely

at the discretion of the Managing Director of BBC. Applications must be done in writing and sent by email to <a href="mailto:membership@brownesbootcamp.co.uk">membership@brownesbootcamp.co.uk</a> .

12. BBC reserves the right to change their membership tariffs at any time although notification of this will be given by BBC on their website 30 days prior to any change in pricing. Notification on the BBC website along with email communications to the member's registered address will be sent out

#### **EXCLUSIONS:**

- 1. All BBC trainers have their own Public Liability Insurance which is available on request and in addition, BBC has its own Certificate of Employers' Liability Insurance also available on request. A list of the trainer's qualifications is available of the BBC website.
- 2. BBC reserves the right to use any individual and group photographs or movie shots of you for use in promotional and media articles, press or promotional purposes authorization of which is displayed on our Members Forms.
- 3. I agree to use BBC facilities in accordance with these terms and conditions as displayed on the BBC website.
- 4. I know of no medical or physical reason why I should not safely participate in an exercise program prescribed by BBC Instructors and I do so entirely at your own risk.
- 5. I understand that Fees are payable as shown above, regardless of my attendance or non-attendance.
- 6. Where BBC members have purchased block sessions these must be used within 3 months from the date of purchase. Under no circumstances will the 3 month period of validity be extended.
- 7. Brownes Boot Camp is registered with ICO (Information Commissioner's Office). We are committed to handling your personal data in accordance with the provisions of the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA) and are registered under the act.
- 8. BBC block cards to remain in one person's name and cannot be transferred or used by any other member.
- 9. All of BBC locations hold their own outdoor training permit from the local council.
